Heavenly Prize, 1995 Go For Wand

Heavenly Prize rolled up a remarkable record in her two-plus years on the racetrack.

The Ogden Phipps homebred knew how to play on a big stage – eight of her nine career wins came in Grade I races, including the Go For Wand at Saratoga, July 23, 1995. In one of her most devastating performances, she crushed four rivals that day, winning off by 11 lengths under jockey Pat Day.

The Go For Wand was among her six Grade I triumphs by 5 lengths or more. In her subsequent start she stayed right at the Spa and made a mockery of the John A. Morris (now named after another Phipps champion, Personal Ensign) cruising home by 8 1/2 lengths.

Like all the Phipps family runners, Heavenly Prize was born and raised at Claiborne Farm in Paris, Ky. There she returned in February 1996 after finishing third to Cigar in the Grade I Donn at Gulfstream Park. She was bred to Storm Cat that spring, but her colt born the following year was never named. Her second chance with Storm Cat yielded the good Grade II-winner Pure Prize, now a promising young stallion with his first runners in 2006.

Heavenly Prize proved she was no fluke as a producer with her fourth foal,

Good Reward. Also by Storm Cat, Good Reward has won three stakes, including Grade I scores in the Hollywood Derby and Manhattan Handicap.

Now 15, Heavenly Prize has a 3-year-old filly by the Storm Cat son Forest Wildcat, a juvenile full brother to Pure Prize and Good Reward named Electrify, and a yearling by El Prado. She is again pregnant to that stallion after foaling a filly this past spring by Awesome Again, sire of Horse of the Year Ghostzapper, among many others.
